

BIRN Macedonia Report 2020

Main activities and results:

- Published over 500 stories, including 70 analysis, 25 investigations, 115 comments, 16 interviews, 10 features and 290 news stories from the country and the region, focused mainly on issues of judiciary, corruption, media and the impact of the pandemic of covid19
- Filed over 40 FOIA requests to over 30 different institutions
- Published five video stories on topic of corruption in different sectors
- Published five animated videos about the effects of corruption in education, public procurement and judiciary
- BIRN journalist was awarded for best investigative story of the year 2019 by the Macedonian Media Institute, MIM.
- Increased journalistic capacities with trainings and workshops (training on uncovering Illicit financial flows)
- BIRN journalists attended several trainings on different topics relevant for their work
